Coinfest will be at the Hilton Hotel (Former Westin - Stamford) One First Stamford Place, Stamford, CT, 06902 Dealer setup will begin at 11 am Friday. The bourse will open to the public at 2 pm and closing at 6 pm. Saturday and Sunday bourse opens to dealers at 8 am to the public at 10 am and closing 6 pm on Saturday and 4 pm on Sunday. Insurance against loss of material is the responsibility of the dealer. Armed security guards will be present from 11 am Friday to 5 pm Sunday. For your protection, please follow any directions of our security personnel. The bourse must be vacated by 5 pm, Sunday.

Coinfest reserves the right to reassign booths at its discretion. Dealers are expected to check-in at registration no later than 2 pm on Friday and **Dealers must occupy their booths until the close of the event on Sunday.** Requests for late check-in or early departure will be honored at the discretion of Coinfest management. In the event that a dealer has not checked in by 6 pm on Friday, their booth(s) may be reassigned or resold at the sole discretion of the Coinfest management with no recourse to the original dealer.

No dealer may knowingly exhibit or offer for sale any illegal coins, counterfeits, forgeries, unmarked copies, or other spurious merchandise. Any such infraction of this rule shall be construed as being against the best interests of numismatics and the Coinfest. The penalty for such action shall be immediate ejection of the dealer from the bourse and the possible suspension and/or subsequent expulsion from future Coinfest conventions. Booth will only be in the name, and only occupied by, the company (dealer) that is the registered exhibitor. The company (dealer) that is registered as the exhibitor may not sublet the booth to another entity without prior written permission of Wanabee, Inc.

The undersign hereby releases Wanabee, Inc. and Hilton Hotel, their respective officers, employees, subcontractors, committee members or volunteers from responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury whatsoever sustained, either directly or indirectly, in connection with this event, and agrees to abide by all conditions of this document.

Cancellation Policy: Notice of cancellation must be in writing. Full booth payment is due at the time the application is submitted. Any booth not paid in full will be subject to reassignment or resold with no recourse to the original dealer. 100% of payment made will be refunded for cancellations received in writing no later than sixty (60) days before show. There are no refunds for cancellations 60 days or less prior to show. Wanabee, Inc. reserves the right to reassign booth numbers at its discretion.
